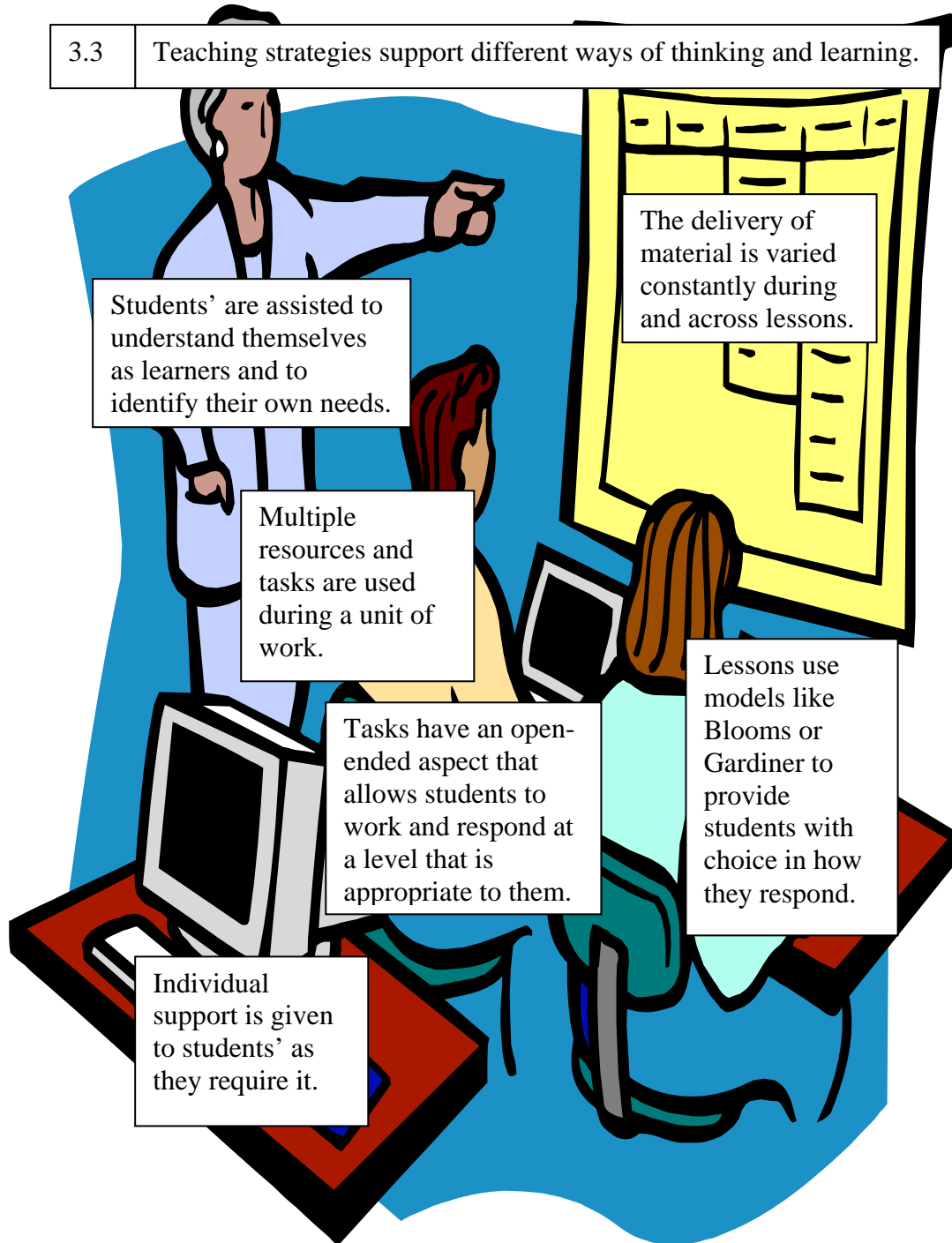


3.3 Teaching strategies support different ways of thinking and learning.



Students' are assisted to understand themselves as learners and to identify their own needs.

The delivery of material is varied constantly during and across lessons.

Multiple resources and tasks are used during a unit of work.

Tasks have an open-ended aspect that allows students to work and respond at a level that is appropriate to them.

Lessons use models like Blooms or Gardiner to provide students with choice in how they respond.

Individual support is given to students' as they require it.
