<p>CREATING AND MAKING At Level 1 students make and share arts works that communicate ideas, feelings and experiences. They explore and use a variety of arts elements, skills, techniques and processes, media, materials and technologies in a range of arts forms. They talk about their own arts works, and arts works and events in their community.</p> <p>In The Arts, standards for the <i>Exploring and responding</i> dimension are introduced at Level 3.</p>	<p>CREATING AND MAKING At Level 2 students create arts works focused on expressive ways of communicating. They demonstrate emerging skills in identifying, selecting and using arts elements, principles, skills, techniques and processes in a range of arts forms. They describe and comment on characteristics of their own and others' arts works.</p> <p>In the Arts, standards for the <i>Exploring and responding</i> dimension are introduced at Level 3.</p>	<p>CREATING AND MAKING At Level 3 students select and combine a range of arts elements, skills, techniques and processes to create and present works in a range of arts forms that communicate ideas and feelings for different purposes and audiences. They identify techniques and aspects of other people's works that inform their own arts making, and refine their work in response to feedback and self evaluation.</p> <p>EXPLOR. & RESPONDING At Level 3 students discuss the use of specific arts elements, skills, techniques and processes in their own works. They describe key features of arts works from their own and other cultures, and use appropriate arts language to describe and comment on their own and other people's arts works and ideas.</p>
